**Day 1 MS Noordam Sail away at 17.00.**

Morning flight to Rome and transfer to the port of Civitavecchia, located a short distance from the eternal city of Rome.

**Day 2 Day at Sea**

**Day 3 Dubrovnik, Croatia 08.00 - 18.00**

Dubrovnik has been described as the 'Pearl of the Adriatic' and rightly so as this lovely World Heritage Site, a former naval city, is clearly special. The magnificent medieval walls surround the beautiful baroque buildings along marble streets full of cafés and shops.

**Day 4 Kerkira, Corfu 09.00 - 19.00**

Regarded by many as the most unique of the Greek Isles because of its lush vegetation, hidden beaches, and near-mountainous scenery, Corfu has always attracted visitors to its shores. Shop for silver in the old Venetian quarter of Kerkyra, in main town, or visit the beach at Paleokastritsa and see if you agree that it is indeed the loveliest in the Mediterranean.

**Day 5 Katakolon, Greece 07.00 - 14.00**

Katakolon is the gateway to Olympia, site of the first Olympic Games which began in 776 B.C. Olympia was a sacred precinct built purposely for the games which were dedicated to Zeus and during which all hostilities were ceased in the name of athletic competition. Visitors can still see the Temple of Zeus and the 45,000 seat stadium. The Archaeological Museum houses sculptures, including the famous "Winged Victory."

**Day 6 Thira (Santorini), Greece  
08.00 - 21.00** - Perched at the very

top of precipitous cliffs, Santorini towers above its original harbour and once could only be reached by foot or mule. Today a cable car offers an alternative route! The island scenery is unique with jagged outcroppings of red and black lava and stairways cut deep in the cliff sides. Buried under volcanic ash from an explosion during the 16th century B.C., are the ruins of ancient Thera.

**Day 7 Kusadasi (Ephesus), Turkey 07.00 - 19.00**

The lively resort of Kusadasi has miles of isolated beaches and is also located near one of the most historical sites, Ephesus, an area of great religious importance. Among the most visited sites in Ephesus are the home where the Virgin Mary lived until her death, the Temple of Hadrian, the Fountain of Trajan and the Street of Curates. Shopping is a popular activity in Kusadasi with countless stores offer a large assortment of carpets, jewelry, leather goods, knitwear, brass and copper along with local handicrafts.

**Day 8 Piraeus (Athens), Greece 08.00 - 18.00**

Piraeus is the main port of Athens, the biggest in Greece, and one of the most important in the Mediterranean Sea. It is within walking distance from Kastella, a hill strewn with beautiful houses that offers a majestic view of the Saronic Gulf. Other points of interest include an archaeological museum, Mikrolimano, where you can enjoy ouzo accompanied by seafood mezedes.

**Day 10 Taormina (Messina), Italy 07.00 - 13.00**

Messina is a large and bustling port city completely rebuilt after a devastating earthquake in 1908. Its astronomical clock, Orologio Astronomico, is the world's largest and is set in Piazza del Duomo. The nearby beautiful resort of Taormina, with its houses clinging to the side of a mountain, is blessed with spectacular views at every turn.

**Day 11 Civitavecchia (Rome) Italy Arrival at 07.00**

Return to Civitavecchia. Transfer and return flight to Malta.
