Tue, 06 Sep - Welcome to Beautiful Washington

Our full day tour will include all the famous landmarks and monuments of this beautiful city including the White House (exterior), Washington Monument, Arlington Cemetery, the Supreme Court and the Capitol Building. Overnight in Washington.

Wed, 07 Sep Philadelphia and New York

An enjoyable drive from Washington to New York with a stop enroute in the famous and historic city of Philadelphia. Highlights tour included. Early evening arrival in exciting New York, The BIG APPLE!

Thu, 08 Sep Exciting New York - Broadway

Begin your day this morning with a full day sightseeing tour of this vibrant city, starting from downtown to Ground Zero, on which, until 11th September 2001, the World Trade Centre complex stood. Other highlights include Wall Street, Chinatown, Little Italy, the Empire State building located on 5th Avenue & West 34th Street as well as Central Park. Enjoy shopping and don't miss out on a Broadway show. Overnight in New York.

Fri, 09 Sep Statue of Liberty

Another exciting day in this pulsating city. We will start our day with an excursion to Ellis Island and Liberty Island. Ellis Island was the main facility for immigrants entering the United States in the late 19th century to the mid-20th century. Ellis Island is one of the most popular tourist attractions in New York. We shall then sail onto Liberty Island to view the grand lady herself – the Statue of Liberty, one of the United States' most iconic attractions. We shall return back to New York City where you can enjoy the afternoon at leisure. Overnight in New York.

Sat, 10 Sep Beautiful New England Cruise - Sail away @ 1700

Check-out of our hotel to embark on our memorable 10-nt New England Cruise Sailing from New York to Quebec City. The St. Lawrence River stretches nearly 1,000 miles from the Atlantic Ocean to the Great Lakes region of North America. It cuts through Quebec, is the home of the famous Thousand Islands region of Canada, and provides fertile fishing waters for Canada's far northern provinces of Newfoundland, Prince Edward Island and Nova Scotia.

Sun, 11 Sep Newport Rhode Island 0700- 1500

Located at the southern tip of the largest island in Narragansett Bay, Newport was established as a colony by William Coddington of Providence in 1639. At the turn of the century, Newport regained importance as a resort for wealthy industrialists, such as the Astors, Belmonts and Vanderbilts. They built their ostentatious "summer cottages," modeled after European palaces, which elevated Newport to the position of undisputed "Queen of Summer Resorts." Today many of these extravagant mansions of the "Gilded Age" are run by the Newport Preservation Society and a tour of at least one of the famous mansions is a must for any visitor. In addition, Newport is also famous as a well-heeled yachting capital and site of international tennis championships. It offers sophisticated boutiques and excellent restaurants.

Mon, 12 Sep Gloucester (Boston) Massachusetts 0900 - 1800

The fishing port was founded in 1623, and ever since it has made its living primarily from the sea. The distinctive statue of The Man at the Wheel marks Gloucester as a seafarer's sort of place. Gloucester, to the north of Boston is America's oldest seaport and the fishing town used in the 2002 film "The Perfect Storm." There's a wealth of existing shore excursion. In Boston enjoy a narrated Trolley Tour where you can hop on and off at all the stops along the route. Boston already serves as one of the leading ports on the U.S. Eastern Seaboard, with myriad attractions. Visitors to Salem can learn about the witch trials and see the major art collections of the Peabody Essex Museum. New Bedford is famous for its whaling history while nearby Fall River offers a Maritime Heritage Trail and Battleship Cove, which offers the world's largest assembly of historic naval ships.

Tue, 13 Sep Bar Harbor Maine 0800 - 1600

Located on Mount Desert Island, which is linked by a bridge to the mainland. Although measuring a mere sixteen by thirteen miles, the island is packed with natural wonders. It boasts the East Coast's only fjord (Somes Sound) and the highest point on the U.S. Atlantic coast with 1,530-foot high Cadillac Mountain. The territory features no less than seventeen mountains, five lakes, hundreds of ponds and streams and the most incredible flora and fauna. Mount Desert Island's most famous attraction is undoubtedly the Acadia National Park. John D. Rockefeller, Jr. considered the island "one of the great views of the world" and donated more than 10,000 acres to the national park. An absolute must is a drive on the 27-mile Park Loop Road, skirting Cadillac Mountain and providing the most incredible views. Afterwards, you may want to stroll the quaint streets of Bar Harbor or indulge in one of the famous lobster meals.

Wed, 14 Sep Halifax Nova Scotia 0900-1700

This vibrant, cosmopolitan, oceanside capital proudly looks back on a rich and varied past. Today, the city is Atlantic Canada's center of business, research and education. Clean, green, walkable streets, excellent dining and friendly maritime smiles welcome visitors in an innovative and historic cityscape. Strong emphasis is placed on cultural diversity, historic restorations and the preservation of the heritage and culture of the people of the region.

USA, Canada & New England Cruise Tour

Thu, 15 Sep Sydney Nova Scotia 0800 - 1700

Sydney is located on Cape Breton Island on the east side of the Sydney River. The town has become an important gateway to the scenic and historic attractions of the Cape Breton Highlands and for cruising on the Bras d'Or Lakes. On the outskirts of the city is the incredible Fortress Louisbourg National Park, presenting Canada's largest historical reconstruction. Here visitors can enjoy "a step back in time" in a town perfectly restored to its 1740 appearance.

Fri, 16 Sep Charlottetown Prince Edward Island 0800 - 1700

Jacques Cartier claimed Prince Edward Island for France in 1534 on his first voyage across the Atlantic and named it Ile-St-Jean. Charlottetown, with a population of nearly 40,000, is the island's capital and one of Canada's oldest towns. Established in 1765 by Capt. Samuel Holland, the settlement was named for Queen Charlotte, wife of King George III of England. The old part of town offers many historical monuments, including important government buildings, churches, old mansions and museums, along with parks and gardens. Outside of Charlottetown, discover miles of farmland, small villages, a scenic coast and the legacy of Lucy Maud Montgomery, author of Anne of Green Gables.

Sat, 17 Sep Scenic Cruising - Gulf of St. Lawrence

Sun, 18 Sep Port Saguenay - Saguenay Fjord - 0800 - 1700

Quebec's sixth-largest city on the delightfully named Ha! Ha! Bay is the gateway to three national parks and some of the most stunning scenery in North America. Hike or windsurf. Look for whales or explore the shops and restaurants of Saguenay's boroughs. The villages along the Saguenay Fjord can be reached by road, but the best way to experience this magnificent waterway is from the water. Where the St. Lawrence and the Saguenay meet is one of the most popular whale-watching spots in Canada. The thriving natural conditions in the estuary support a permanent colony of a thousand whales. Beautiful views of the length of the fjord are found at Cap Trinite, a cliff that rises above the channel, with a 33-foot statue of the Virgin Mary surveying the scenery from the lowest ledge.

Mon, 19 Sep Quebec City Quebec 0800 - Overnight on Board

Being Canada's most historic city and the only walled city in North America earned it the classification of World Heritage Treasure by UNESCO in 1985. Today, the visitor is greeted by an authentic, profoundly French city, where 95% of its half million people are French-speaking. Both parts of the city - Haute-Ville and Basse-Ville (Upper and Lower Town) - feature winding, cobbled streets flanked by 17th- and 18th-century stone houses and churches, graceful parks



and squares and countless monuments. Croissants and steaming cups of coffee at a sidewalk café conjure images, aromas and sounds of Paris. Great emphasis has been placed on Québec nationalism; as a result the city has become a symbol of the glory of French heritage. The motto "Je me souviens" (I remember) is inscribed above the entrance to the Parliament Building and on the license plates of Québec cars. As you come ashore, endless pleasures await you in this marvelous city. Overnight in Quebec City.

Tue, 20 Sep Quebec - Montreal - Niagara Falls 0700

Our cruise comes at an end today when we disembark at Quebec. Our coach will be waiting to transfer us to Niagara Falls, however, en-route we shall stop in Montreal, the largest city in the province of Quebec and the second largest city in Canada. It has a distinctly European feel and a delightful mixture of old and new where period buildings that line the streets of Old Montreal blend wholly with the modern buildings which come in unexpected shapes and colours. Highlights in Montreal include the breathtaking Notre Dame Basilica, the Botanical Gardens, and the many 18th & 19th century buildings of Vieux-Montreal which have now been adapted into cafés, shops and galleries. Overnight in beautiful Niagara.

Wed, 21 Sep Niagara Falls including Maid of the Mist

Today's full-day exciting excursion begins with a thrilling ride on board the 'Maid of the Mist', which will take us as close as possible to the roaring cascade of the Niagara Falls. This powerful vessel will take us from the Canadian docks past the base of the American Falls, then onto the basin of the magnificent Horseshoe Falls. A raincoat will be provided to keep you dry from the mist and spray! At the end of the tour you will enter the Maid of the Mist Plaza which includes gift shops and a food outlet. In the afternoon we shall drive onto Niagara-on-the-Lake to discover this quaint and charming village with its Victorian architecture. Evening time is when the Niagara Falls becomes even more magical as they are lit with every colour of the rainbow, truly a sight not to be missed. Overnight in Niagara.

Thu, 22 Sep Beautiful Toronto

On our excursion to Toronto we will enjoy a panoramic tour to see many of the city's ethnic neighbourhoods and learn about its long and varied history. This is the largest and most diverse city in Canada, perched on the shores of Lake Ontario. With the soaring CN Tower a major landmark, downtowns glass-and-steel office towers give way to Toronto's charming theater district, with museums nearby. Not to be missed in Toronto is Yonge Street; stretching at 1900km it is not only the longest street in Canada but also in the world! Overnight in Niagara

Fri, 23 Sep Day at leisure in Niagara. Depart to Malta
